| Requirements: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. You must be an American citizen.2. You must be a Maryland resident and a student at a Maryland High School.3. You must have had at least two years of German study. | | | |

4. The application must include **two letters of recommendation**, one from your German teacher and one from another teacher.
5. The application must include a copy of your high school transcript.
6. You must write two essays. One essay should be in German, about 150 words, telling about yourself, your family and your free time activities. The second essay should be in English explaining why you want to go to Germany. This essay must be at least 300 words.
7. You must appear for a personal interview with members of the German Society of Maryland Education Committee.
